UCC IP Policy

• IP

- Patents, copyright, trademarks, designs, domain names, software algorithms and code, data, databases, confidential information, trade secrets and know-how, plant breeders' rights
- Policy provides a platform to enable IP protection and commercialisation
- Obligation to disclose IP
- Anticipates licensing IP to industry and forming spin-out companies
- Shares revenue from licensing with staff and students
- Shares equity in spin-outs with staff and students
- UCC Innovation manages these activities

New Ventures: Start-ups and Spin-outs

- Start-up: company formed by staff or students from the RPO not based on knowledge or IP generated by the RPO and where there is no formal IP licence or equity share with the RPO
- Spin-out: a company based primarily on knowledge and/or intellectual property originating from the RPO in which the RPO holds equity and/or has a licence to the IP
- UCC provides supports to enable formation of both types of company

- Use of facilities
- State aid
